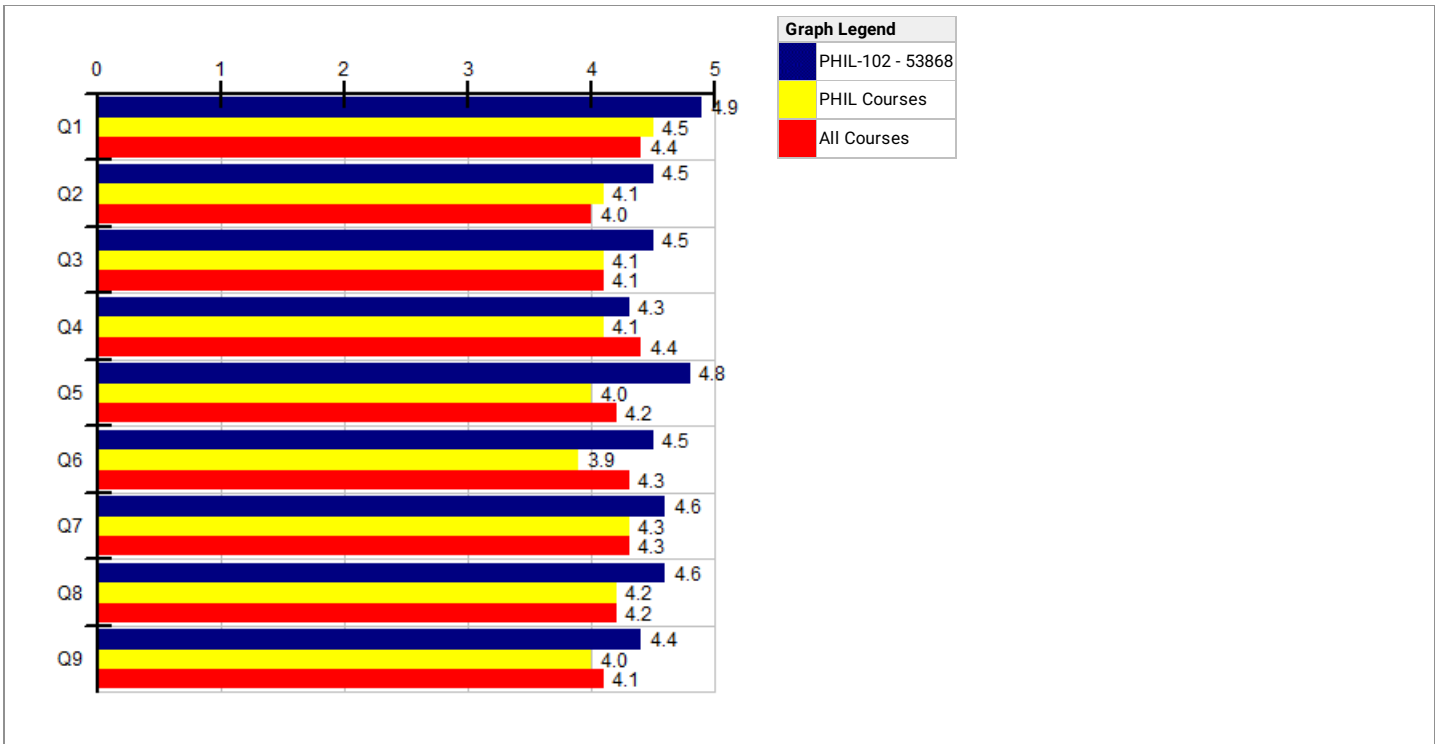

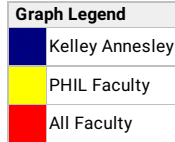
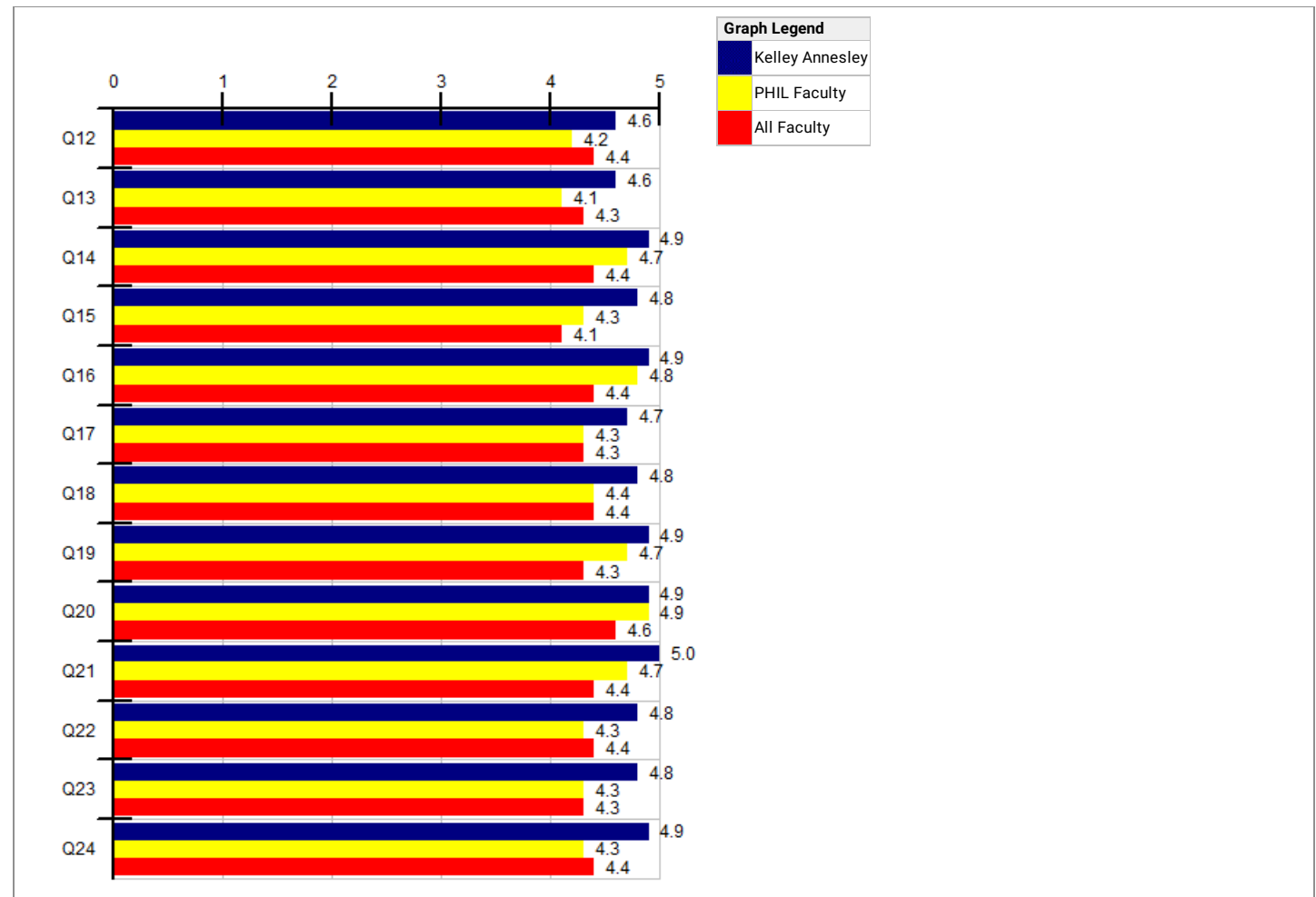
1	The more reality oriented material and references to more modern topics. Especially the references to current political events that especially I thought were prevalent and important to talk about.

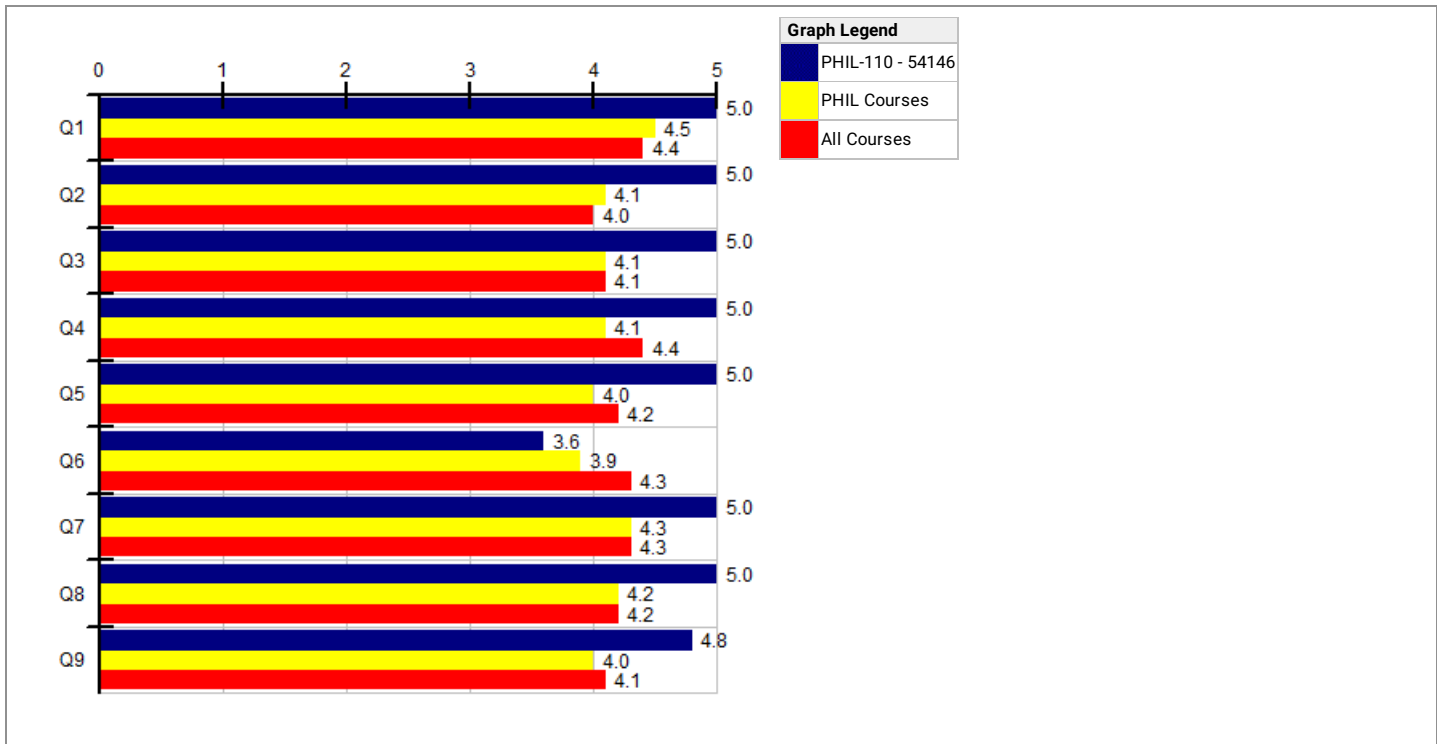
Q25 - If a student asked whether you would recommend this course from this instructor, what would you recommend and why?
